As a United Methodist Congregation, we have an 'Open Communion.' This means that All are welcome to receive the bread and juice. The Sacrament of Communion offers the opportunity for an encounter with Christ, and all are invited to participate and receive His grace.

We receive Communion by Intinction - meaning a server will place a piece of bread in your hand and then you are to dip the bread into the cup. As you receive the bread, and also as you dip the bread into the cup, you may respond by saying, "Amen" or "Thanks be to God".
