As a United Methodist Congregation, we have an 'Open Communion.' This means that **All** are welcome to receive the bread and juice. The Sacrament of Communion offers the opportunity for an encounter with Christ, and all are invited to participate and receive His grace.

We receive Communion by Intinction - meaning a server will place a piece of bread in your hand and then you are to dip the bread into the cup. As you receive the bread, and also as you dip the bread into the cup, you may respond by saying, "Amen" or "Thanks be to God".

What is Pentecost?

Pentecost is the day on which the Christian Church commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and others assembled in Jerusalem. It marks the beginning of the Christian church and the proclamation of its message throughout the world.

Commissioning of Immokalee Misison Team

The Immokalee Mission team is being commissioned today at the 9:45 a.m. service. We will have over 70 people (middle school, high school, college students and adults) that will be working on 5-6 different sites to repair the homes of needy people in Immokalee, FL. These work projects include roofing, flooring, and drywall repairs. There will be some bathrooms replaced, as well as some electrical, plumbing, painting and landscaping work done. Our team will also be putting on a Vacation Bible School (VBS) for the children of Immokalee. While the construction work and VBS are important, the real objective of our mission work is always to "build" relationships and make the name great of our Lord Jesus Christ!
