2018 IMMOKALEE MISSION TRIP

"For the 10th straight year the Soldiers For Christ Student Ministry will be heading to a small community in south Florida called Immokalee (meaning "My Home" in Miccosukee Indian language) to be the "hands and feet" of Jesus! A caravan of PHUMC church vehicles and cars loaded down with students, adults and lots of supplies will pull out of the PHUMC parking lot this coming Sunday (6/24) for a week's worth of work repairing homes, building relationships and putting on the "Shipwrecked" Vacation Bible School program for some less fortunate children in south Florida.

The work projects include re-shingling one home, replacing the water damaged floor of another home, patching a roof and repairing a kitchen for yet another home. We will also be helping the IMMCAA non-profit entity with repairs to their office building (which got ripped open during hurricane Irma last fall). Each day starts early with breakfast and devotions and continues with long hours of hard work in the south Florida sun.

At night we have some free time before dinner. Then we wrap up with “big group” time, which consists of testimonies, praise n’ worship music and a message. It’s hard to believe that working hard for God and others can be so rewarding and fun! Many students on this year’s trip have a special place in their hearts for Immokalee because they either accepted Christ in a prior year on this trip, or have special memories of how He moved in their hearts and lives.

We have a group of over 50 students and adults this year that God will turn from a ‘group’ into a ‘team’, and from a ‘team’ into a ‘family’! We are excited about what God has planned for us next week. While we expect to give everything we can to help the people of Immokalee, God’s blessings on us always overshadows what we give! No doubt we will return on Saturday (6/30) as different people; people who have been in the presence of God.
