

This is the second Sunday of Advent and we light the candle of Peace. I'm sure we all long for peace. We have lived through such a tumultuous year that we hope and pray that we will find peace and hope this Christmas and in the coming year.

This Sunday we also begin holding two very different worship services. I hope you have already chosen the one you want to try first and then will check out the other one online. That way you will get a better idea of which one best inspires you to worship.

The 8:30 Traditional Service will include lighting of the Advent Wreath, carols, hymns and traditional worship. After children have been checked in at the Children's Ministry desk, they will attend worship with their parents until after Children's Moment, when they will be invited to go to their Kindle groups. Parents will pick them up after the service in their classrooms.

The 10:30 Modern Service will be designed to be a relaxed worship experience. The music style will be similar to the majority of the music we currently enjoy at the 9:30 service, featuring songs that you would hear on hit Christian radio, like JoyFM. Before service, children will be checked in at the Children's Ministry desk for their own worship time in the Children's Room (A201) where they will enjoy high-energy music, games, a lesson, and lots of fun. Parents will pick up their children after service from their classrooms. Of course, children may remain with their parents in worship during both services.

Let's prepare our hearts for the coming of the Prince of Peace as we worship this Sunday.
