This week's message will come from John 11:1-4; the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead and from Luke 10:38-41; the story of Jesus visit to the home of Lazarus, Mary and Martha. I will portray Martha.

Mary and Martha were sisters and they both loved Jesus. Yet, they were very different in how they showed their love and gratitude to Jesus. Martha often gets a lot of criticism. Yet, I can really sympathize with Martha. She was showing her love for Jesus by making a special meal for him and his disciples.

Have you ever cooked a big meal for a lot of people? For several years I would do Christmas dinner for my family. There were children and their spouses, grandchildren and their spouses and children. By the time dinner was over and the gifts opened, I just wanted everyone to go home. At that point, I wished I could be Mary and sit.
