Our Board of Education ministries are making a difference for the Kingdom.

Here at Palm Harbor United Methodist Church we are blessed with phenomenal ministries through our Board of Education. We have The Robin's Nest Preschool, Stars and Comets After-School Program, Camp Cubber (summer Camp) and Westlake Christian School. Throughout this year, we want to highlight each of these ministries at one of our Sunday Worship Services.

Since these happen in the daytime, you may not be familiar with or even know of the magnitude these ministries have to children and families of our church and community. I believe we are making a Kingdom difference through the efforts of these ministries.

This coming Sunday, we will celebrate the ministry of Westlake Christian School. We are celebrating the 25th Anniversary!!! Yes, 25 years ago as a mission/ministry of the PHUMC, Westlake Christian School began with its first class of just eight students. Today, there are 426 students!!! The Kindergarten through 8th grade classes are ministered to by over 65 faculty/administration.

Westlake has endeavored to create a challenging academic program within a nurturing, Christ-centered school setting. It endeavors to educate children to know God, understand themselves, and transform their community for Christ. It is Accredited by the Florida Kindergarten Council, the Florida Council of Independent Schools, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools/AdvancED, and a member school of the Association of Christian Schools International, Westlake has also earned the National Blue Ribbon School Excellence status.

We will celebrate the 25th Anniversary on Sunday at each service. Part of our celebration will be the dedication of the new building just recently finished. You will be able to visit the

new facility after each service with an official tour and reception at noon.

During the services on Sunday, we will see some videos especially made for the celebration. Westlake Concert Band will be a part of some of the services, as well as the school's Eagle Chorus.

The sermon title is "Rooted in the Past, Celebrating the Present, Cultivating the Future." May we continue to remember as it says in Psalms 145: "One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts."
