

Romans 10:5-15

Does what we believe really matter?

Do you ever feel guilty? I feel guilty when I lose my cool and say things I regret. I feel shame when I realize that I have failed to be the person God created me to

be.

In our scripture lesson for this Sunday Paul is trying to help the Romans understand the difference between guilt and shame. If they tried with all their being to fulfill all the requirements of Leviticus, the law, they couldn't possibly do it. We couldn't do it. Paul seems to be saying that if you think that keeping all of God's statutes and ordinances is easy, then you don't know all God's statutes and ordinances. Righteousness that comes from obedience to the law is just not going to happen.

There is a distinction between "guilt" and "shame". Guilt comes from breaking the law. Shame comes because you got caught breaking the law.

Paul says that the only way we can be free of guilt and shame is through our faith in Jesus. We are made righteous. We don't earn it by repenting, or by good works, or anything we do. This is all about the good news, the gospel, it is free. It is ours simply by believing.
