

### [Psalm 119:105-112](#)

In the last verse of this portion of Psalm 119, the psalmist says: "My heart is set on keeping your decrees to the very end."

The psalmist has been facing all sorts of difficulties, yet he reaffirms his vow to be faithful to God to the very end.

It is human nature when we are going through difficult times, to get lost in the dark. We begin to question our faith and to wonder if God has deserted us. It is also tempting to desert God. We turn away from the faith that has sustained us in the past.

This is a time in our lives like none other any of us has ever known. It is very much like walking in the dark. We need help to see our way through the dark. The psalmist says that God's word is a lamp to show the way. Yet, if we do not read and study and apply God's word to our lives, it is like a lamp that has gone out.

Perhaps we need to join the psalmist and declare that our hearts are set on keeping God's decrees until the very end. Or as Paul said: "No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:38)

So, friends, let's turn to God's word to give us the light we need to guide us through these dark and difficult days.
