### James 3:3-5; Proverbs 18:21

Our scripture lesson for this week comes from James 3:3-5. Did you know that James was the brother of Jesus? Some scholars believe that James is the best evidence in the divinity of Christ. Why is that?

Imagine this: What would your brother have to do to convince you that he was the Son of God? Think about that. If James thought Jesus was the Son of God, that's pretty good evidence. So, if James, the brother of Jesus, said: You know what we can make a large horse go wherever we want by means of a small bit in his mouth and a little small rudder makes a huge ship turn wherever the pilot chooses to go, even though the winds are strong. Likewise the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts."

This week we are going to be looking at the life-giving and the life-taking words our tongues speak. The Proverbs passage says that the tongue has the power of life and death. I often speak before I really think, so I'm going to need to hear this sermon as well as write it. Let's see what I discover that may help us all.




